$$\frac{x+1}{x^2+4x+4}$$

$$\frac{x}{(x^2+1)(x+1)(x+2)}$$

(d)
$$\frac{2x+5}{(x^2+1)^3(2x+1)}$$

2. Compute the following integrals.

(a)
$$\int \frac{x-9}{(x+5)(x-2)} dx$$

(b)
$$\int \frac{1}{x^2 + 3x + 2} dx$$

(c)
$$\int \frac{x^3 - 2x^2 + 1}{x^3 - 2x^2} dx$$

(d)
$$\int \frac{x^3+4}{x^2+4} dx$$

(e)
$$\int \frac{1}{x(x^2+1)} dx$$

3. Compute

$$\int \frac{1}{\sqrt{x} - \sqrt[3]{x}} \, dx$$

by first making the substitution $u = \sqrt[6]{x}$.
