The Graduate Program Committee discussed the status of the Masters of Science in Applied Math degree. In view of developments in the department in the areas of math biology, machine learning and numerical analysis, and math finance and economics, and the Dean's interest in offering 3+2 masters programs, it would seem that the best option would be to keep this program on hold until either of these research groups or the department's activity in the Dean's initiative, makes re-activation of the MSAM an attractive and practical option.
