"R. L. Moore and the Moore method"

The Moore method is a way of teaching mathematics by having the students develop the subject under the guidance of an instructor, rather than having the subject developed for them by the instructor. The Moore method is named after R. L. Moore of the University of Texas at Austin. Don Buckholtz, Tom Hayden and Jim Wells of the UK Department of Mathematics have taken courses from Professor Moore when they studied in Texas.
